Whether your agency has established a Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) or not, this course will provide strategies for officers to conduct a thorough investigation, enhance victim participation and increase the likelihood of prosecution. The instructional team includes a law enforcement officer, a prosecutor, and an advocate, all of whom have extensive experience handling sexual assault crimes
