## ***Firearms Instructor Update***

**Course Description:** The objective of the Firearms Instructor Update Course is to allow experienced law enforcement firearm instructors the opportunity to refresh their existing skill set, while being exposed to in-depth topics such as stress inoculation, human performance limitations, case studies, current training methodologies and expand existing knowledge and instruction base. All topics and items used during the course presentation will be made available to the student instructors so they may be implemented into existing programs should the attendees choose to do so.

**Prerequisite:** Students must be a full-time sworn law enforcement officer and have successfully completed a Firearms Instructor Course. Rifles must be sighted in before first day of class.

**Equipment:** Duty handgun with 3 magazines, duty rifle with 2 magazines, duty belt, ballistic vest, 500 handgun rounds, 500 rifle rounds, eye and ear protection. This course will consist of one day handgun, one day rifle, and one day of patrol-based vehicle tactics. Participants have the option of utilizing only handgun or a combination of pistol and rifle during the vehicle portion. A total of 250 rounds will be needed during vehicle tactics (handgun or handgun/rifle).

**Attire:** The dress for this class is relaxed due to the instruction requirements. It is recommended that the students attend in BDU's or their department's deployment uniform.

**Note:** All courses provided at the Fresno Police Department Regional Training Center (FPDRTC) are open to the public with satisfactory completion of pre-requisites as indicated for each class. Courses offered to the general public at the FPDRTC meet Title 5 requirements under the California Code of Regulations. Courses may be cancelled due to low enrollment, or unforeseen circumstances, such as special operations or law enforcement emergencies.
