TACTICAL PATROL RIFLE ADVANCED JULY 12, 2019

Course Description:

This course is designed to provide advanced tactical training to enhance an officer's performance when deploying a patrol rifle. Training will include classroom instruction on use of force, lethal force, and threat assessment. Intensive range training with live fire and incorporated tactical response scenarios will further enhance the officer's skills.
This course meets the PC 33220 requirement.

- Equipment:** Duty handgun, duty belt, ballistic vest. Rifle: carbine-style platform (i.e. Colt AR-15 or similar. No Mini-14 or similar rifles). Ammo: 100 rds handgun, 300 rds .223. Suitable eye and hearing protection.
FPD personnel: The Training Unit is unable to provide training rifles. Students are encouraged to utilize rifles assigned to their district.
- Attire:** Members attending range or physical training may wear jeans (in good condition), tennis shoes and other leisure/recreational attire. Shirts may not contain offensive language, logos, or otherwise be unprofessional. No shorts or open toe footwear. However, members *should* change into regular duty attire prior to returning to duty *unless otherwise authorized by their supervisor. Officers will wear clothing that will minimize the appearance of any tattoos.* **Procedure 208.**
